



## GROUNDBREAKING FOR NEW CENTRE PARK

On July 16, the Town held the official groundbreaking for New Centre Park on Memorial Drive. Officials from the Town, York County, Clover School District and Chamber of Commerce joined with representatives from Withers and Ravenel, the project engineers; Beam Construction, the contractor; and the community to celebrate the construction of Phase 1 of the park. Phase 1 will include four soccer fields, a concession stand/restroom facility, and parking lot as well as a number of utility improvements.

## TAX MILLAGE

Effective for the 2012 tax year, the millage for Town property taxes will increase by a total of 8 mills. Council approved a 4 mill increase for operations (from 110 to 114 mills) and a new 4 mill assessment for capital projects (New Centre Park). For an owner occupied home valued at \$100,000, the property tax will increase from \$440 to \$472. The new millage is expected to increase Town revenues by \$132,800; half of which will be used for capital projects.

## COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Town Council will be considering approval of the Comprehensive Plan 2022. The Plan defines what kind of community we want to be in the future and describes what we have now and what we want 5-10 years from now. The Plan is the culmination of 2 ½ years of study and was approved by the Planning Commission on April 25, 2012. A public hearing is scheduled for September 10, 2012, 6:30pm, at the Clover Community Center. The public is invited to attend and comment on the Plan. 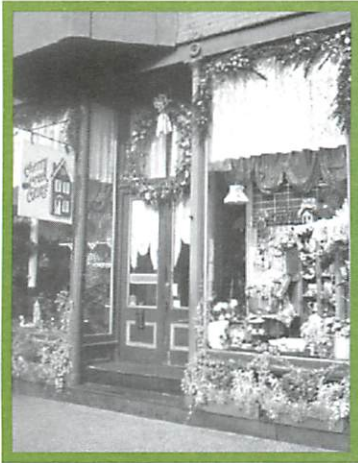

## CLOVER FAÇADE GRANTS

The Town of Clover is offering assistance to commercial property owners to repair and improve the exteriors of their buildings. Up to five \$1,000 competitive grants are expected to be awarded through the Façade Grant Program. Qualifying projects are eligible for a grant of up to \$1,000 per exterior on a 50/50 matching basis with a minimum investment of \$300 per property. Improvements must be consistent with and visibly improve the original or historic character of the building. Suggested improvements include painting, signage, awnings, doors, windows, lighting, and restoring the original materials and finish.
