BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL

All Town of Clover 2012-2013 Business Licenses expire on June 30, 2013. According to the Business License Ordinance, license renewal fees must be paid for each business subject to the applicable rate classification on or before July 31, 2013. Failure to renew will result in a 5% penalty for each month you are delinquent.

In-Town Businesses Only: When renewing your business license, you **MUST** bring in a copy of your tax return for verification of gross receipts. If you have not had your taxes completed, please bring a letter from your CPA confirming your gross receipts. A business license may not be issued without verification. All contractors will also need to present a copy of their South Carolina State Contractors License.

Renewal applications will be mailed in June to make the application process more convenient. Please contact Town Hall at 222-9495 with any questions concerning your business license renewal fee. Also, visit www.cloversc.org for more information.

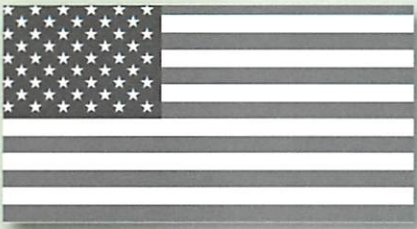

The Town of Clover has completed the 2012 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report. This report is designed to inform customers about the quality water the Town delivers to you every day. The Town's goal is to provide you with a safe and dependable supply of drinking water. So as to ensure the quality of your water, the Town continues to take steps to improve the water treatment process and to protect water resources. Clover's water is purchased from Two Rivers Utilities, Gastonia, North Carolina, and their water source is Mountain Island Lake located off Highway 273 in northeastern Mount Holly, North Carolina.

The Town of Clover's drinking water is safe and meets federal and state requirements.
