### OPEN BURNING

Over the last few weeks, the Town has received several complaints of smoke caused by burning leaves. Residents are reminded that such burning inside the Town is done by permit only. Permits are issued at no cost at Town Hall during normal business hours.

Curbside leaf collection is underway. Make sure to keep sticks out of your leaf pile. Also, do not block storm water flow lines along curbs or on the street as doing so will clog storm water drains and cause flooding.

### LATE NOTICES

Effective January 1, 2014, the **Town of Clover will no longer be sending late notices** to customers who have failed to pay their water/sewer bill by the due date. Water bills are due by the 15th of each month. A 10% late fee will be applied after the 15th. Failure to make a payment agreement by the 20th or failure to pay by 9AM on the 21st of each month will result in a \$30 administrative fee applied to the account even if the water has not physically been turned off.

The billing statement customers receive at the beginning of each month will serve as the only notice of the amount due. Customers have a variety of ways to remit payment including the drop box at Town Hall, on-line bill pay, and bank draft.
