

SPRING CLEANUP WEEK

In an effort to assist property owners with their clean up efforts, the Town of Clover will allow owners to place miscellaneous and bulk items at the curb for pick up from May 19-23. During this week only, the Town will collect appliances like washers and dryers, refrigerators and stoves; paint; batteries; electronic garbage including TV's and computers and any other item not normally accepted.

Items must be placed at the curb in an organized manner, separated into like piles. Call Town Hall to request an extra roll out container if you will be disposing of a lot of loose items. The Town will not clean up or collect items like cars, boats, mobile homes or any other item that will not fit in the dump truck. The Town will provide assistance elderly and handicapped citizens; call Town Hall for more information and to schedule a time.

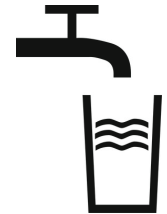
