

CLOVER FAÇADE GRANTS

The Town of Clover is offering assistance to commercial property owners to repair and improve the exteriors of their buildings. Up to five \$1,000 competitive grants are expected to be awarded through the Façade Grant Program.



Qualifying projects are eligible for a grant of up to \$1,000 per exterior on a 50/50 matching basis with a minimum investment of \$300 per property. Improvements must be consistent with and visibly improve the original or historic character of the building. Suggested improvements include painting, signage, awnings, doors, windows, lighting, and restoring the original materials and finish.

All commercial properties are eligible to apply.

KEEP STORM DRAINS CLEAN

It is important to remember to keep the Town's storm drains clear of all debris so as to prevent unnecessary flooding and contamination of our lakes and streams. At no time should debris of any kind be placed in the flow line of the curb or on the street. Leaves, grass clippings, other yard debris and garbage should be placed well behind the curb and never in any area that could restrict water flow. Town Ordinance prohibits obstruction of any storm drains or ditches; fines may be applied on those violating this ordinance. We ask for your cooperation by doing your part to keep our storm drains as clean as possible.
