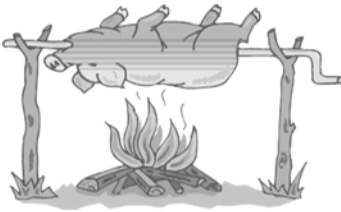


BUTTS & BLUEGRASS BBQ FESTIVAL

WATER CONSERVATION

Clover customers are encouraged to use water responsibly and conserve where possible. Conservation actions may include:

- Limit watering to 2 or 3 days per week and use low volume, drop irrigation and handheld watering devices.
- Reduce washing down of sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, and other hard surfaced areas.
- Reduce washing down structures and buildings for purposes other than immediate fire protection or repairs.
- Reduce residential washing of vehicles. Use car washes that use recycled water instead of washing vehicles at home.

If the drought status changes, notifications will be posted on the Town's website and Facebook page. A press release will also be sent to the Enquirer Herald and other local media.

FAÇADE GRANT & MAIN STREET MAKEOVER GRANT

The Town of Clover is offering assistance to commercial property owners to repair and improve the exteriors of their buildings. All applications are due by 5:00pm on September 11, 2015. Improvements may include painting, signs, awnings, doors, windows, lighting, landscaping and/or parking lot improvements.

The **FAÇADE GRANT** will fund up to \$2,000 on a 50/50 matching basis. For example, for a \$2,000 project, the grant would reimburse \$1,000. Applicants are encouraged to consult with design professionals to develop an application that will meet the grant requirements and Town zoning ordinances and building codes.

Starting this year, the Town is also offering a new funding opportunity called the **MAIN STREET MAKEOVER GRANT**. The maximum grant award is \$300 but there is no match requirement. Special consideration will be given to new businesses (open less than 3 years).
