TIME TO VOTE

The Municipal Election will be Tuesday, November 3rd. Although an equal number of candidates filed for the number of available seats on Town Council, there will be an election due to write-in candidates.

The York County Bond Referendum question will also be on the ballot. The question will ask if you are in favor of issuing general obligation bonds, i.e. debt that is backed by property taxes, in the amount of \$89,770,000 to build a new Family Court Facility, expand and improve the Moss Justice Center and improving the Clover and Fort Mill Magistrate's offices.

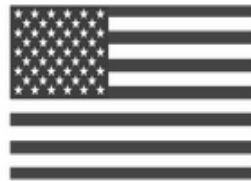

TURKEY GREASE—DO NOT PUT DOWN THE SINK

Thanksgiving means TURKEY!! It also means a lot of grease! The simplest way to get rid of fat is down the drain. There it congeals and traps food scraps which causes clogged pipes.

To avoid these problems and a big plumbing bill:

- Pour grease into a container, let it congeal then discard the container in the trash.
- Avoid putting stringy or fibrous waste down the disposal
- Do not wait until the disposal is full to turn it on. Use plenty of water, and let it run for 20 or 30 seconds until it is clear.
