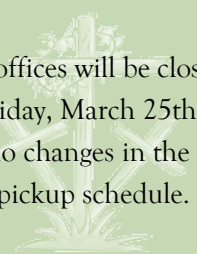

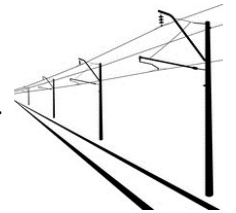
DOG REGISTRATION

Dog Registration is underway! Proof of current vaccinations is required. The registration fee is \$4 per dog. The Town will host a Rabies Clinic on Saturday, **April 30, 2016** from 9:00AM - 12:00PM at 114 Bethel Street. All dogs residing within the Town limits are required to be registered for the 2016 calendar year by April 30.



REQUEST LIGHT REPAIR

Duke Energy maintains numerous outdoor lights to help promote safety and security in public areas. Let them know if an outdoor light or streetlight is out or not working properly.



The first rule of safety is do not touch a power line or anything touching a power line, such as tree limbs, tools and toys. Even power lines that have fallen may be dangerous and should not be moved or disturbed.
