

Spring CLEANUP Days

In an effort to assist property owners with their cleanup efforts, the Town of Clover will allow owners to place miscellaneous and bulk items at the curb for pickup from **May 16-20**. During this week only, the Town will collect appliances like washers and dryers; refrigerators and stoves; paint; batteries; and any other item not normally accepted. We will NOT collection electronic garbage such as computers and televisions. Residents must take these items to one of the County's Convenience Centers.

Items must be placed at the curb in an organized manner, separated into like piles. Call Town Hall to request an extra roll out container if you will be disposing of a lot of loose items. The Town will not cleanup or collect items like cars, boats, mobile homes or any other item that will not fit in the dump truck. The Town will provide assistance to elderly and handicapped citizens; call Town Hall at 222-9495 for more information and to schedule a time.
