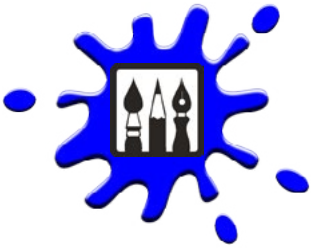

Photography II Ages 13+

A basic photography opportunity for teens and adults to learn the basics of photography compositions, light, the rule of thirds and other basic photography skills. Students will also make their own personal sketchbook.

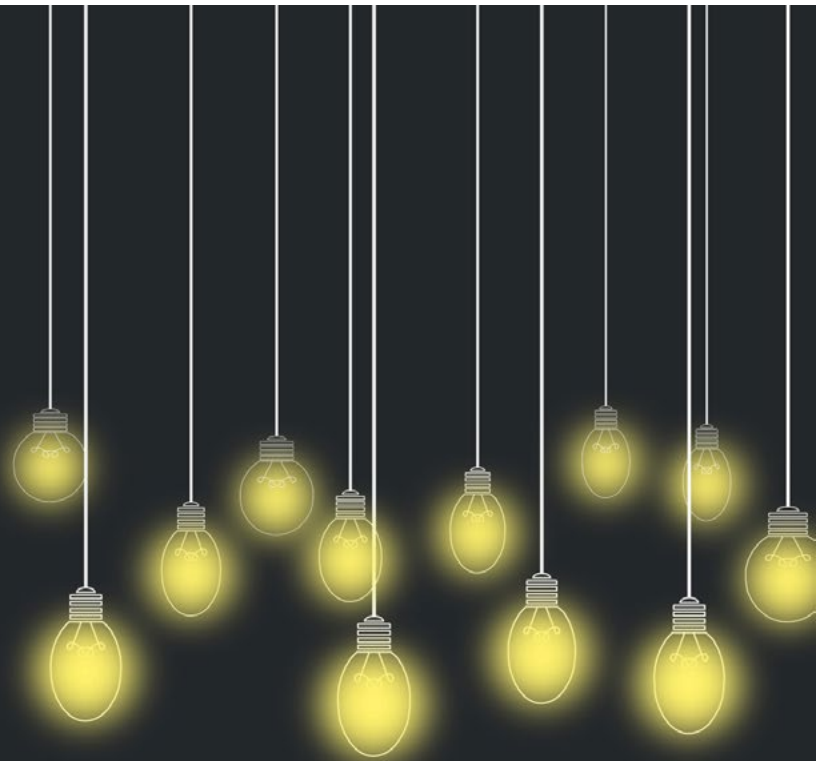
All student work will be displayed/juried at Blue Eagle Academy at our "Night of the Arts" on August 4.
