BETHEL STREET RESURFACING PROJECT UPDATE

The SCDOT continues to excavate the rock between Bethel Street and Elizabeth Avenue to create space for a stormwater drain that is necessary to install before they can resurface Bethel Street. Staff estimates it will take another 2 weeks to complete the drain up to Bethel Street. The stormwater pipe will have to cross Bethel which will mean rock excavation in the roadway for an undetermined amount of time. This will mean lane closures, delayed travel times and further deterioration of the road. Travelers are encouraged to use alternate routes like Marion Street or Clinton Avenue to Knox Street. Once the stormwater pipes are installed across Bethel Street, the SCDOT will begin resurfacing.
