TOWN TO ACQUIRE TWO NEW PROPERTIES

In January, Representative Tommy Pope introduced legislation that would allow the SC Budget and Control Board to transfer the Clover National Guard Armory on Memorial Drive to the Town. As of this time, the bill, H 3180, is awaiting final reading by the Senate. The Town also purchased the long vacant bank building at 116 Bethel Street, beside the existing Town Hall. The Town plans to renovate this building and move Town Hall staff in by the end of the year. The Building Official, Code Enforcement and Municipal Court staff is expected to move into the old town hall. The town is pleased to have purchased this building for \$171,000 when the asking price had been \$390,000. The building has fallen into disrepair over the years and the renovation will greatly improve the town's appearance. The drive through window will also provide another convenient way for customers to pay their water bill.
