



## Annual Spring Cleanup

In an effort to assist property owners with their cleanup efforts, the Town of Clover will allow owners to place miscellaneous and bulk items at the curb for pick up from May 18-22. During this week only, the Town will collect appliances like washers and dryers, refrigerators and stoves; paint; batteries; electronic garbage including

TV's and computers and any other item not normally accepted.

Items must be placed at the curb in an organized manner, separated into like piles. Call Town Hall to request an extra roll out container if you will be disposing of a lot of loose items. The Town will not clean up or collect items like cars, boats, mobile homes or any other item that will not fit in the dump truck. The Town will provide assistance to elderly and handicapped citizens; call Town Hall for more information and to schedule a time.

## COUNTY TAKES OVER ANIMAL CONTROL

Effective May 1, 2015, York County will take over animal control activities in the Town of Clover. The County will pick up unwanted, stray, or injured dogs and cats. The County does not remove wild animals such as snakes and raccoons from private property. Starting May 1, citizens should report lost dogs/cats and strays to York County at 628-3190 or via their website at [www.yorkcountygov.com/animalcontrol](http://www.yorkcountygov.com/animalcontrol). The Town will continue to remove deceased animals from Town roadways; report to Clover Public Works at 222-7700. The Clover Police Department and Town Code Enforcement will continue to respond to and investigate nuisance complaints and dangerous animals.
