NEEDS PUBLIC HEARING

The Town Council will hold a Needs Assessment Public Hearing on Monday, January 11, 2016, at 6pm at the Clover Community Center, 120 Bethel Street. This meeting will give citizens an opportunity to ask questions about planned projects and to identify the additional needs of the Town of Clover. PREPARE PIPES FOR WINTER

Now is the time to insulate exposed pipes, spigots and backflow preventers with special made covers or just plain old towels. When temperatures begin to fall below freezing for extended periods, let an indoor faucet drip.

COUNCIL APPROVES SECOND ROUND OF GRANTS

The Town Council approved offering a second round of grants to assist commercial property owners to repair and improve the exteriors of their buildings. All applications are due by 5:00pm on February 12, 2016. Improvements may include painting, signs (new & repairs), awnings, doors, windows, lighting, landscaping and/or parking lot improvements.

The **FAÇADE GRANT** will fund up to \$2,000 on a 50/50 matching basis. For example, for a \$2,000 project, the grant would reimburse \$1,000. Applicants are encouraged to consult with design professionals to develop an application that will meet the grant requirements and Town zoning ordinances and building codes.

The **MAIN STREET MAKEOVER GRANT** will fund minor projects up to \$300 and there is no match requirement. Special consideration will be given to new businesses (open less than 3 years).
