

## MACK MCCARTER AWARD WINNER 2015

On Monday, March 14, 2016, Clover High School Social Studies teacher, Frank Falls, was announced as the recipient of the 2015 Mack McCarter Award. Mr. Falls established Moped to Memphis in 2008 when he felt his Social Studies students should be involved in some sort of community service project. Several charities were listed but every student voted for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. That year, the students raised \$3,200. During the 2009-2010 school year, Mr. Falls challenged his students to raise \$6,220. If the students raised that amount, he would deliver the money by driving a moped to Memphis, TN. That year Mr. Falls delivered \$13,000 to St. Jude. In 2010-2011 school year, \$30,000 was raised. Each year more and more money has been raised for St. Jude Children's Hospital by students and volunteers from Clover by selling T-shirts & stickers, raffles, womanless beauty pageant, etc. So far, Moped to Memphis has donated nearly \$445,000 with a goal of \$1,000,000 by 2020. 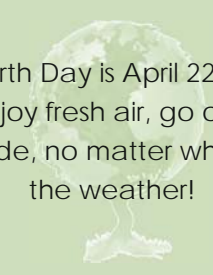

## RECYCLING CHANGES

Effective April 4, 2016, you will no longer be able to recycle glass in your recycle bin. York County will no longer accept glass that is co-mingled with other recycling. The York County Convenience Centers will accept separated glass if you would like to continue recycling your glass.

Also note that the Town no longer picks up e-waste such as televisions, computers, etc. These items must also be taken to the Convenience Centers.
