

BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL

All current Town of Clover Business Licenses expired on June 30, 2016. According to the Business License Ordinance, license renewal fees must be paid for each business subject to the applicable rate classification on or before July 31, 2016. Failure to renew will result in a 5% penalty for each month of delinquency.

In-Town Businesses Only: When renewing your business license, you MUST bring in a copy of your tax return for verification of gross income. If you have not had your taxes completed, please bring a letter from your CPA confirming your gross receipts. A business license may not be issued without verification.

All contractors will also need to present a copy of their South Carolina State Contractors License.

Renewal applications will be mailed in June to current license holders. Contact Shannon Nix at 222-9495 or snix@cloversc.org with any questions concerning your business license renewal fee. Information about the Town's business license program is also available online at www.cloversc.org.

Residents are reminded that all businesses doing work in the Town of Clover are required to have a business license including home improvement contractors, carpet and house cleaners, and home based businesses.

COUNCIL ADOPTS BUDGET

On June 13, following a public hearing, the Town Council adopted the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget which goes into effect on July 1, 2016. The budget provides for the revenues and expenditures that are expected over the next year for the Town's General, Water/Sewer, Capital Projects, Hospitality Tax and other special funds.

Council adopted increases in water and sewer rates in accordance with the 2013 rate study and in anticipation of a 2% rate increase from Two Rivers Utilities. The water/sewer increase is expected to impact the average 4,000 gallon-a-month, in-town residential property by about \$28 per year.

An ordinance to adopt the property tax millage rate will be considered at the Council's July 11 meeting.

Notable expenditures include New Centre Park Phase 2 engineering and construction, replacement of the sewer lift stations that serve the Hillcrest and Cloverbrook neighborhoods through a Community Development Block Grant, and parking lot improvements at the Clover Community Center.

The approved FY16-17 Town budget will be available for review at Town Hall and on-line at www.cloversc.org on July 8.
