COUNCIL CONSIDERS TAX INCREASE

Town Council approved a two mill property tax increase for the purpose of funding a full-time firefighter position. The millage would increase from 116 to 118. In tax dollars, the average home owner will pay approximately \$9 more per year in Town property taxes. The increase is expected to raise \$34,000/year in tax revenue.

At their meeting on September 12, Council will consider final reading of Ordinance 16-05. The increase will go into effect for tax year 2016.
