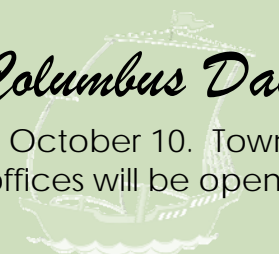

FALL LEAF REMOVAL

It's that time of year! Fall leaf removal begins October 1st.

Please observe the following rules to ensure collection:



- Leaf piles should not have sticks or any other debris mixed in. These items can lodge in the tubing of the leaf machine causing tears and clogging which will damage the machine. These items should be removed while raking or blowing your leaves into the pile.
- When placing your leaves on the curb, do not pile them in the guttering of the street where rain water flows down the side of the road.
