Over the course of the year, the Town finished plans for New Centre Park Phase 2 and obtained the funding needed to get started with construction, grappled with a difficult zoning issue involving a cell tower, and made recycling collection changes when the County decided to no longer accept glass. Over a million dollars in grants were obtained to improve the water and sewer system. Gallery 120 showcased the work of local artists and two new youth summer camps were offered. Growth of the town continued with the opening of several new businesses and the increase in new construction in all of our residential subdivisions.
