

NOTICE OF ELECTION 2017

The next Town of Clover election will be held on November 7, 2017. The offices of the Mayor and Six (6) Council members are two-year terms and all seats are up for election.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above offices must file with the York County Registration and Elections office, E.C. Black Building, 13 S. Congress St., York, SC. Candidate filings will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 9, and will close at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 8. The filing fee for the office of Mayor is \$60 and for Council is \$45. Citizens choosing to file for candidacy must be a resident of the Town of Clover and a qualified elector (registered voter).

Should only one person file for the office of mayor and no person files a declaration to be a write-in candidate within (14) fourteen days after filing closes, the sole candidate who filed for the Mayor's office shall be declared the winner. Should an equal number of candidates for council file for the same number of council seats available and no persons have filed a declaration to be a write-in candidate within (14) fourteen days after filing closes, those candidates shall be declared the winners.

Any person desiring to **register to vote** for this election must do so in person no later than Friday, October 6, at the York County Registration and Elections office, E. C. Black Building, 13 S. Congress St., York, SC. For those registering to vote by mail, applications must be postmarked no later than October 9. YARD WASTE COLLECTION REMINDERS

- Yard waste cannot be placed in containers or mixed with garbage, appliances, metal or household articles.
 - Yard waste should be organized into like piles. Limbs are chipped curbside and should be no more than 8' long, less than 8" in diameter, and manageable by one person.
 - From April to September, leaves must be bagged.
 - Do not place leaves or any other object anywhere that will block storm drains, sidewalks or roadways.
 - The Town does NOT collect yard waste, building materials or refuse from building operations or landscape contract work. The contractor is responsible for removing these items. Also, we do not collect from nonresidential property.
- REMINDER: The Town does not collect electronics. Please take televisions, computers, monitors, etc. to one of York County's Convenience Centers.
