## COUNCIL ADOPTS BUDGET

On June 12, following a public hearing, the Town Council adopted the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget which will take effect July 1, 2017. The budget provides for the revenues and expenditures that are expected over the next year.

The approved budget does not include an increase in property taxes, water and sewer rates or sanitation fees. An ordinance to adopt the property tax millage rate will be considered at the Council's July 10 meeting; no millage increase is proposed.

Notable expenditures include New Centre Park Phase 2 construction, Community Development Block Grant project to replace lift stations at Hillcrest and Cloverbrook, improvements at Calabash Waste Water Treatment Plant, and renovation of the old Town Hall for use by the Town's municipal court.

The approved Town budget will be available for review at Town Hall and on-line at [www.cloversc.org](http://www.cloversc.org) on July 7.
