FUN FACTS ABOUT SNOW



1. All snowflakes have 6 sides and form in a variety of shapes
2. Snow crystals are translucent, not white. The white coloring is caused by sunlight that is reflected off the crystals. All visible colors are reflected, which together, look white.
3. Most snowflakes fall at a speed of 2 to 5 feet per second, roughly the same speed as a person casually walking.
4. A "snowflake" can be one ice crystal, several ice crystals stuck together, or even a "puffball" of crystals that fall from the clouds.
5. A blizzard is a heavy snowstorm that lasts for more than three hours, with winds exceeding 35 mph, creating low visibility.
