DOG REGISTRATION & RABIES CLINIC

Dog registration is underway! All dogs residing within the Town limits are required to be registered for the 2018 calendar year by April 30th. Owners must provide proof of current Rabies vaccinations. The registration fee is \$4 per dog. Beginning May 1st, there is a \$10 penalty for late registration.

In addition, the Town will hold our annual Rabies Clinic on Saturday April 21, 2018, 9:00 am - Noon, behind the old Town Hall, 114 Bethel Street. A local veterinarian will be available to administer Rabies shots to your pet at a charge of \$8.00 per pet, per shot.



RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERS

Part of being a responsible pet owner means being a good neighbor and abiding by the Noise Ordinance and Leash Laws. York County handles Animal Control for the Town of Clover. Animals are required to be fenced in, on a leash, or under the control of their owners at all times when outside.
