## Spring CLEANUP Days

We will NOT collect electronic items such as computers and televisions. Residents must take these items to one of the County's Convenience Centers.

The Town will not cleanup or collect items like cars, boats, mobile homes or any other item that will not fit in the dump truck. The Town will provide assistance to elderly and handicapped citizens. ### MICRO-FARM RULES

Have you ever thought about owning chickens or other "farm animals"?

Micro-farms are allowed in R-20, R-12, R-7 and R-5 zoning districts provided the lot size is 10,000 square feet or greater and there is only one house on the lot. Micro-Farms consisting of the following animals up to the maximum number listed are allowed:

- four (4) chickens (no roosters allowed)
- one (1) pot belly pig
- two (2) pygmy goats

Farm animals must be kept and housed in the rear yard only, and there must be at least 100 square feet of undeveloped & unpaved land per animal in the rear yard area. Properties are limited to 4 total animals. A permit for a micro-farm is required.



Also, no more than four (4) dogs may be kept on any residential lot. If there are also farm animals on the property, the total combined number of dogs and farm animals cannot exceed four (4).

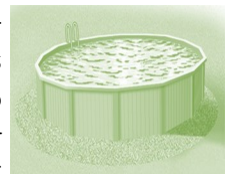
