

## DOG REGISTRATION & RABIES CLINIC

The Town will hold our annual Rabies Clinic on **Saturday April 13, 2019** 9:00 am - Noon, behind the Municipal Court (old Town Hall), 114 Bethel Street. A local veterinarian will be available to administer Rabies shots



to your pet at a charge of \$9.00 per pet, per shot. Town staff will also be on hand to register your dog for the 2019 calendar year. The dog registration fee is \$4 per year per dog through April 30th. After May 1st, there is a \$10 late registration fee. Only dogs living inside the Town limits are required to be registered.
