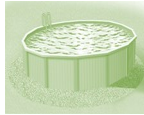
PARKS AND RECREATION

Spring CLEANUP Days

In an effort to assist property owners with cleaning up their properties, the Town of Clover will collect miscellaneous and bulk items at the curb from **May 20-24, 2019**. During this week only, the Town will collect appliances like washers and dryers, refrigerators and stoves, paint, batteries, and many other items not normally accepted. We will NOT collect electronic items such as computers and televisions. Residents must take these items to one of the County's Convenience Centers.

Items must be placed at the curb in an organized manner, separated into like piles. The Town will not cleanup or collect items like cars, boats, mobile homes or any other item that will not fit in the dump truck. The Town will provide assistance to elderly and handicapped citizens. PUBLIC HEARING

The Clover Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, May 13, 2019, on proposed changes to terms of office for the Town Council and the date of taking office. The Council is considering increasing terms from two (2) years to four (4) years and staggering the terms such that the Mayor is elected every 4 years and 3 council seats are elected every 2 years. Council is also considering making the effective date for taking office the first regular meeting in January following the November election instead of at the first meeting in November following the election.
