Week of July 29 th	Pre-season practices begin for all age divisions during this week (Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Friday and Saturdays).
Saturday, August 24 th	Pre-Season practice will end; coaches will have to schedule additional practices after this date
Week of August 26 th	Regular season begins
Friday, September 6 th	Picture Day at New Centre Park (picture schedule TBD)
Week of September 30 th	Post-season tournaments for all age groups will begin (Single Elimination Tournaments)

Practice space is limited and practices may take place Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday.

Games will/may be held at Clover Community Park, Roosevelt Park, York Sports Complex, Fort Mill Recreational Complex or Doby Bridge Park in Fort Mill.

Primary game days are Monday, Tuesday and Thursday evenings at 6:00pm, 7:15pm & 7:30pm. In the event of a game cancelation, due to weather or unplayable field conditions. Rescheduled make-up games will be scheduled as soon as possible and will be held on any day of the week (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday). * In the event of inclement weather Clover Parks and Recreation reserves the right to shorten the season by canceling games, adjusting the tournament lay-out or scheduling double-headers.
