2019 ELECTION

The next Town of Clover election will be held on November 5, 2019. The offices of the Mayor and Six (6) Council members are up for election. The Mayor and the top three vote getters for Council seats will serve a 4 year term and the other three Council members to serve a two-year term.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above offices must file with the York County Registration and Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 6. The Election office is located in the Government Center, 6 S. Congress St, Room 1201, York, SC. The filing fee for the office of Mayor is \$60 and for Council is \$45.

Citizens choosing to file for candidacy must be a resident of the Town of Clover and a registered voter. Any person desiring to **register to vote** for this election must do so in person no later than Friday, October 4, at the Election Office, on-line at www.scvotes.org by Sunday, October 6, and by mail on October 7 (postmarked).
