

2019 TOWN OF CLOVER ELECTION

The next general election for the Town of Clover will be held on November 5, 2019. Current Mayor Greg Holmes will be running unopposed. There are eleven candidates running for the six available Town Council seats. Incumbents Todd Blanton, Chris Farris, Teresa Hurst, Wes Spurrier and Debbie Williams are running for re-election along with newcomers Keon Barber, Raymond Bayly, Martha Bratton, Amy Nivens, Ashely Pannell, and Scott Shuler. This election will begin the Town of Clover's change to staggered terms. The top three vote-getters for the Council seats will serve a four-year term along with the Mayor. The next three top vote getters will serve two-year terms. Register to vote by October 4! The Clover Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, October 14, 2019, at 6:30 PM at the Clover Community Center, 120 Bethel Street, on Ordinance 18-14 to amend the Town of Clover Zoning Map such that the zoning district designation for property owned by David Cuthbertson located at 1016 N. Main Street, Tax Map No. 010-08-01-121, be changed from PDD Planned Development (underlying zone B-4 Neighborhood Commercial) to B-2 Highway Commercial.
