RESIDENTIAL MORATORIUM

The Town Council approved Ordinance 19-12 which establishes a temporary moratorium on residential development. The purpose of the moratorium is to give time for staff to research and make a recommendation to the Planning Commission and Town Council on residential design/architectural standards for the exterior of all new construction. Public meetings to obtain input from citizens, real estate professionals, design professionals and builders will be scheduled.
