DOG REGISTRATION

Yearly Dog registration began on January 1st! All dogs residing within the Town limits are required to be registered for the 2020 calendar year no later than April 30th. Dog Owners should visit Town Hall at 116 Bethel Street with proof of current Rabies vaccinations. The registration fee is \$4 per dog. Beginning May 1st, there is a \$10 penalty for late registration. Our annual Rabies Clinic and Town of Clover Registration will be held on **Saturday, April 25th, 9am-12noon**, behind the Municipal Court (formerly the old Town Hall building), 114 Bethel Street.
