COVID-19

Dear Clover Parks & Recreation Patrons,

Thank you for your understanding during these unprecedented times. As recreation professionals, the health and wellness of the Clover community is always our top priority and the department intends on being part of the solution slowing down the spread of the coronavirus. The following actions have been taken to ensure our park users and staff safe and healthy, while complying with the Governor's Executive Orders and following SC DHEC's recommendations:

- Town of Clover parks, trails, and open spaces are available so that individuals can enjoy the mental and physical health benefits these spaces have to offer. Users must continue practicing the six feet of social distancing and no more than 3 or more people gathering, as directed by the Governor.
- The Clover Community Center is closed. Staff members are still working and available by phone or electronically, Monday-Friday, 9:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M.
- The playgrounds at Roosevelt Park and Clover Community Park are closed until further notice.
- Restrooms in parks will only open Monday-Friday, 6:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M.
- Shelter reservations and use is suspended through April 30, 2020.

Please use the parks responsibly so that they remain open and providing a benefit to our community during this outbreak.

Staff members are working on incorporating some creative activities through technology rolled out soon to keep the community engaged and healthy during this challenging time.
