IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Pursuant to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and concern for the health and safety of the public and judicial staff, **Clover Municipal Court has canceled July 2020 court dates.**

IMPORTANT: CASES WILL BE RE-SCHEDULED:

When Court operations resume (date to be determined), notice of your court date will be mailed to your last known address. It is your responsibility to notify the Court if your mailing address changes.

You may pay the fine without having to appear in court if the ticket indicates: **Court Appearance Required – “NO”** is circled. (**NOTE:** If you have misplaced/lost your ticket, call the Court to confirm you may pay without having to appear in court.)

Fines can be paid by:

- Pay online: cloversc.org
OR
- Mail or drop-off a cashier's check / money order payable to Clover Municipal Court. (Enclose a copy of your ticket or put the ticket number on your payment)
OR
- Bring exact cash only between 8:00am - 4:00pm, Monday through Friday
OR
- Payment plan: You will need to call the Court between 8:00am – 4:00pm, Monday through Friday, to discuss a payment arrangement

If you received a ticket(s) for: insurance / registration / driving without a license; or fix-it ticket: lights; muffler; window tint; unsafe vehicle, you may contact the officer who issued the ticket(s) and provide the necessary documentation/proof that you have resolved the issue(s). It will be at the officer's discretion on how to proceed with the ticket(s).

If you:

- have been appointed the Public Defender: Clover Municipal Court cases only, contact York County Public Defender's Office at (803) 628-3031.
- have hired an attorney, please contact him/her for information.
- are a victim in a case(s): Clover Municipal Court cases only, contact the Victims Advocate Office at (803) 628-3259.

Clover Municipal Court will be monitoring the situation and updates will be made as warranted.
