## BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWALS

All Town of Clover business licenses expire each year on June 30. Business have the month of July to renew without penalty.

## WHO NEEDS A TOWN OF CLOVER BUSINESS LICENSE?

Per the Business License Ordinance, **every person or entity**, engaged or intending to engage in any calling, business, occupation, or profession, in whole or in part, within the limits of the Town of Clover is required to pay an annual license tax for the privilege of doing business and obtain a business license (Ord 03-17, passed 1-12-2004). A Business is defined as A Calling, occupation, profession, or activity engaged in with the object of gain, benefit, or advantage, either directly or indirectly.

Do you sell clothing, make-up or food products? Do you rent property? Whether you have a store-front business or you operate your business from your home, if you are obtaining income from the business, you are required to have a Town of Clover business license. ## COVID-19 BUSINESS RECOVERY ASSISTANCE GRANT

Town Council has approved a grant program for in-town businesses to assist with COVID-19 related expenses. The Town is offering recovery grants of up to \$500 to eligible businesses and industries that were negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic resulting from governmental orders to close or limit operations. This is a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED GRANT, not a loan, that will reimburse for expenditures for COVID-19 related items such as PPE's for employees; cleaning and disinfectant; signage, outdoor dining and building modifications; and certain utility bills if the business had to close. Businesses must be physically located within the Town limits of Clover and have a valid Business License. Non-profits and home-based businesses are not eligible.
