

COVID-19 BUSINESS RECOVERY ASSISTANCE GRANT

Town Council approved a grant program for in-town businesses to assist with COVID-19 related expenses. The Town is offering recovery grants of up to \$500 to eligible businesses and industries that were negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic resulting from governmental orders to close or limit operations. This is a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED GRANT, not a loan, that will reimburse for expenditures for COVID-19 related items such as PPE's for employees; cleaning and disinfectant; signage, outdoor dining and building modifications; and certain utility bills if the business had to close. Businesses must be physically located within the Town limits of Clover and have a valid Business License. Non-profits and home-based businesses are not eligible. The Façade and the Main Street Maker grants may also become available later in the year. Details will be provided at that time.

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Clover Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, August 10, 2020, at 6:30 PM at the Clover Community Center located at 120 Bethel Street on the following ordinances:

- Ordinance 20-07 amending the Zoning and Land Development Ordinance so as to revise design and development standards for new residential dwelling subdivision and new multifamily residential dwelling development ("Residential Design Standards").
- Ordinance 20-09 establishing the zoning district designation for newly annexed property owned by Deep Geet, LLC, at 1140 Highway 55 East, Tax Map No. 379-00-00-059, consisting of 1.0 acre, to B-2 Highway Commercial, and amending the Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map so as to amend the Land Use Type for referenced property to Corridor Commercial.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION REMINDERS

- Yard waste cannot be placed in containers or mixed with garbage, appliances, metal or household articles.
- Yard waste should be organized into like piles. Limbs are chipped curbside and should be no more than 8' long, less than 8" in diameter, and manageable by one person.
- From April to September, leaves must be bagged.
- Do not place leaves or any other object anywhere that will block storm drains, sidewalks or roadways.
- The Town does NOT collect yard waste, building materials or refuse from building operations or landscape contract work. The contractor is responsible for removing these items. Also, we do not collect from non-residential property.
