COVID- 19 GUIDELINES & BEST PRACTICES

Clover Parks and Recreation has implemented **COVID-19** guidelines & best practices in accordance to SC Governor McMaster's and Accelerate SC recommendations. In order to continue to operate in a responsible and safe manner, we are asking for all staff, youth sports participants and spectators to follow such guidelines, which include:

- Specific Entrances and Exits: each park/facility has a specific lay-out for everyone to follow.
- Face coverings shall also be required at all Town-sponsored special events when 6' social distancing cannot be achieved such as when entering the facility or park, using restrooms, at concession stands, etc.
- ALL players should be socially distanced when not actively playing. No team huddles, no high fives, etc. All players should have socially distanced station to place their bags and equipment.
