## LEAVES

From November to April of each year, leaves can be raked to the curb for pick-up instead of being placed in bags. In order to ensure your leaves will be collected, please make sure that leaf piles only contain leaves and are free from any sticks or other debris mixed in. These items can lodge in the tubing of the machine causing damage. When placing your leaves on the curb, please do not pile them in the guttering of the street where rain water flows down the side of the road. This will cause back-ups and flooding along those areas.
