

WATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

On February 14, 2021, the Town launched **Love Your Neighbor**, a water bill assistance program to raise funds for those that need financial help with their monthly water bills.

Town of Clover water customers may voluntarily enroll to add a fixed, monthly donation to their water bill. It can be \$1 or \$5 or any other whole dollar amount. The selected amount will be added to the monthly water bill. Donated funds will be transferred to a special account that will be restricted for financial assistance to those in need. The Clover Area Assistance Center will administer the program by evaluating customers for eligibility for financial assistance and issuing payment vouchers.



If you are interested in enrolling in the Love Your Neighbor program as a donor, complete the enrollment form online at www.cloversc.org or enroll at Town Hall during normal operating hours. You will need your customer account number found on the water bill.
