One year ago, this newsletter covered the many changes that the Town made to protect the safety of our citizens and our staff. STREET NEWS

- ◆ After April 1st, all leaves must be bagged before being placed at the curb for pick up.
- ◆ When mowing, please do not blow your grass clippings into the roadway. This can create blockages in the storm drains and become hazardous to vehicles when wet.
- ◆ To keep our Town clean from litter, please place all loose trash in bags before putting it into the rollout bin.
- ◆ If you have more bags of trash than the rollout bin can hold, please call for a special pick-up, 803-222-9495, and we will try to accommodate as best we can.
- ◆ Always keep 6' of area clear around your rollout so that the arm of the trash truck can grab the container.

WATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Sign up now for the **Love Your Neighbor** water bill assistance program. Raised funds will help those that need financial assistance with their monthly water bills.

Town of Clover water customers may voluntarily enroll to add a fixed, monthly donation to their water bill. It can be \$1 or \$5 or any other whole dollar amount. The selected amount will be added to the monthly water bill. The Clover Area Assistance Center will administer the program by evaluating customers for eligibility for financial assistance and issuing payment vouchers.

Donors may complete the enrollment form online at www.cloversc.org or enroll at Town Hall during normal operating hours. You will need your customer account number found on the water bill.
