The Clover Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, June 14, 2021, at 6:30 PM at the Clover Community Center located at 120 Bethel Street. There are two items on the Public Hearing Agenda. (1) Ordinance 21-07 to amend the Town of Clover Zoning Map such that the zoning district designation for property owned by Borgman Builders Inc. located at 614 Kings Mountain Street, Tax Map No. 010-02-05-011, be changed from B-4 Neighborhood Commercial to R-7 High Density Residential. (2) On the Municipal Budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

2021 SUMMER ART CAMPS

Summer Art Camp Registration will be open until June 25, 2021. Classes will be offered for two weeks, July 12-16 and also July 19-23. *Each week will cost \$70 per camper.* Temperature checks will be made at the door and masks are highly recommended for the safety of both campers and instructors.

Classes offered will be:

- **Drawing (Ages 13-16)**
 - This is for campers who want to learn basic drawing skills. Observational drawing, perspective, and techniques are taught using graphite, color pencils and charcoal. This will be a structured and disciplined studio experience.
- **Visual Arts (Ages 8-12)**
 - This camp provides an experience in multiple art mediums and techniques. Campers will paint, draw, collage and create a sculpture during the week.
- **Photography (Ages 8-12)**
 - Campers will learn about composition, light, color, illusion, point-of-view, and all the basics of good photography. **Campers will need a digital camera for this camp.**
