PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing will be held on Monday, August 9, 2021, at 6:30pm at the Clover Community Center, 120 Bethel Street, on Ordinance 21-19 to amend the Town of Clover Zoning Map such that the zoning district designation for property owned by Kennedy Living Trust located at 406 N. Main Street, Tax Map No. 010-03-09-049, be rezoned from B-2 Highway Commercial to R-7 High Density Residential. NOTICE OF ELECTION

Congratulations to Council member Tina Goodgame on winning the Special Election held on July 6th.

The next Town of Clover election will be held on November 2, 2021. The election will be for four (4) Council seats. Three (3) of the seats will be for a four-year term and one (1) seat will be for a two-year term.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above offices must file with the York County Registration and Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 3. The Election office is located at 6 Congress Street, York, SC, Room 1201. The filing fee is \$45.

Citizens choosing to file for candidacy must be a resident of the Town of Clover and a registered voter. Any person desiring to **register to vote** for this election must do so in person no later than Friday, October 1, at the Election Office, on-line at www.scvotes.org by Sunday, October 3, and by mail on October 4 (postmarked).

WHO NEEDS A TOWN BUSINESS LICENSE?

Per the Business License Ordinance, **every person or entity**, engaged or intending to engage in any calling, business, occupation, or profession, in whole or in part, within the limits of the Town of Clover is required to pay an annual license tax for the privilege of doing business and obtain a business license (Ord 03-17, adopted 1-12-2004).

Do you sell clothing, make-up or food products? Do you rent property? Whether you have a store-front business or you operate your business from your home, if you are receiving income from the business, you are required to have a Town of Clover business license. BUSINESS GRANTS AVAILABLE

The Town of Clover is offering two opportunities for assistance to commercial property owners to repair and improve the exteriors of their buildings. Improvements may include painting, signs, awnings, doors, windows, lighting, landscaping and parking lot improvements.

The Façade Grant and the Main Street Makeover grant applications are available at Town Hall and at www.cloversc.org. Both grants are competitive and funding is limited. All projects must meet Town Zoning and Land Development Ordinance and Building Code requirements.
