PUBLIC HEARING

The Clover Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, September 13, 2021, at 6:30 PM at the Clover Community Center, 120 Bethel Street, on Ordinance 21-08 annexing property located at 1079 Tom Joye Road, with York County Tax Map Number 364-00-00-063, and property located at 1085 Tom Joye Road, with York County Tax Map Number 364-00-00-004 and to establish a zoning classification of R-12 Medium Density Residential for said properties.

TOWN ELECTION

The next Town of Clover election will be held on November 2, 2021. The election will be for four (4) Council seats. Three (3) of the seats will be for a four-year term and one (1) seat will be for a two-year term.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above offices must file with the York County Registration and Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 3. The Election office is located at 6 Congress Street, York, SC, Room 1201. The filing fee is \$45.

Citizens choosing to file for candidacy must be a resident of the Town of Clover and a registered voter. Any person desiring to **register to vote** for this election must do so in person no later than Friday, October 1, at the Election Office, on-line at www.scvotes.org by Sunday, October 3, and by mail on October 4 (postmarked).
