

CLOVER TOWN COUNCIL ELECTION

The next Town of Clover election will be held on Tuesday, **November 2, 2021**. The election will be for a total of four (4) Council seats. Three (3) of those seats will be for new four-year terms and one (1) seat will be for a two-year term, to fill a vacant seat. Those candidates registered to run for the three (3) four-year term seats are incumbents Ke'on Barber, Teresa Hurst, and Tina Goodgame, along with William "Bo" Legg, Amy Moses, Scott Schuler, and Michael Walters. Candidates Brittany Farr and Kitisa McDowell are registered to run for the two-year term.

Any person desiring to **register to vote** for this election must do so in person no later than Friday, **October 1**, at the Election Office, on-line at www.scvotes.org by Sunday, October 3, or by mail on October 4 (postmarked).

The Greater Clover Chamber of Commerce plans to host a "Meet the Candidates" event. The tentative date is October 20th. Check the Chamber's Facebook for final details information. The Town will also post the information to our website and Facebook pages.

FALL LEAF REMOVAL

It's that time of year again! Fall leaf removal begins on October 1st. Please observe the following rules to ensure collection:

- Leaf piles should not have sticks or any other debris mixed in. These items can lodge in the tubing of the leaf machine causing tears and clogging which will damage the machine. These items should be removed while raking or blowing your leaves into the pile.
- When placing your leaves on the curb, do not pile them in the guttering of the street where rain water flows down the side of the road. This will create issues with storm drains.

WATER METER ACCESS

Do you know where your Water Meter is located? The Town of Clover needs access to your water meter at all times. Please make sure that there is nothing planted or covering the lid. The technicians need three feet of clearance when working at the meters. Your meter should always be visible and accessible to the Town, never located behind a locked gate nor covered by anything.
