COVID-19 COMMUNITY VACCINATION CLINIC

Piedmont Medical Center and the City of Rock Hill have established a community clinic to administer the COVID-19 vaccine in York County to eligible persons. If you are eligible per SCDHEC, visit www.cityofrockhill.com/COVID19 to submit a Vaccine Request Form. Appointments and email addresses are required. The vaccination site is the Galleria Mall in Rock Hill.

LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR WATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

February is the month Love is shown through cards, chocolates and flowers. The Town of Clover is proud to announce another way you can show Love. On February 14, 2021, the Town will launch **Love Your Neighbor**, a water bill assistance program that will raise funds for those that need financial help with their monthly water bills.



Town of Clover water customers may voluntarily enroll to add a fixed, monthly donation to their water bill. It can be \$1 or \$5 or any other whole dollar amount. The selected amount will be added to the monthly water bill. Donated funds will be transferred to a special account that will be restricted for financial assistance to those in need. The Clover Area Assistance Center will administer the program by evaluating customers for eligibility for financial assistance and issuing payment vouchers.

If you are interested in enrolling in the Love Your Neighbor program as a donor, complete the enrollment form online at www.cloversc.org (will be available on February 14) or enroll at Town Hall (via the drive thru) during normal operating hours or call Town Hall at 803-222-9495. You will need your customer number found on the water bill.

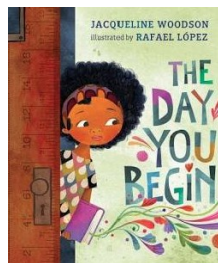
Spring 2021 Youth Sports Registration ends on February 5th. T-Ball registration will be open until February 19th.
