## BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL

All Town of Clover Business Licenses expire on **April 30, 2022**. The Business License Ordinance was amended in 2021 to be in compliance with the South Carolina Business License Standardization Act which included a mandatory change in due date for business licenses. License renewal fees for gross revenues earned in 2021 must be paid on or before April 30. Residents are reminded that all businesses are required to have a business license **including home based businesses**.

**In-Town Businesses** MUST provide in a copy of 2021 tax return for verification of gross income. If you have not had your taxes completed, please bring a letter from your CPA confirming your gross receipts. A business license may not be issued without verification. *All contractors will also need to present a current copy of their South Carolina State Contractors License.*

Renewal applications will be mailed to current license holders. ## PUBLIC HEARING

The Clover Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, April 4, 2022, at 6:30 PM at the Clover Community Center, 120 Bethel Street, on the following Ordinances:

- Ordinance 22-01 to amend the Zoning and Land Development Ordinance by amending sections of the ordinance pertaining to Conservation Subdivisions, including Section 7.4, Site Design Standards for Conservation Subdivisions; Section 4.4, Common Open Space; and Section 10.3, Types of Applications.
- Ordinance 22-03 to rezone property located at and around 602 Old North Main Street, commonly referred to as the Coltex Mill site, consisting of Tax Parcels 010-02-11-001, 010-02-11-002, 010-02-11-003, 010-02-11-004, 010-02-11-005, 010-02-11-006, 010-02-10-005, and 010-02-11-023, which are currently zoned ID Industrial so as to rezone said eight parcels to establish a single PDD Planned Development District (PDD-2022-01).
